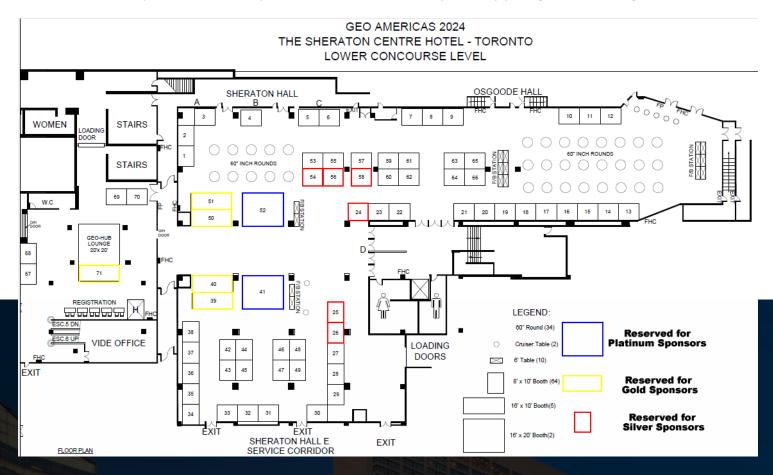


5 EXHIBIT HALL MAP
